

SMUHSD 2017-18 Academic Achievement Report

The District has compiled for each of its common academic outcome measures, a three-year (2015-17) disaggregated report and set of annual targets for the district overall and each site for the 2017-2018 school year. The common measures addressed in this report are as follows:

- *Estimated Graduation Rates*
- *A-G Completion (denominator excludes non-grad track SpEd Students)*
- *D/F Rates in Algebra I & English I (fall semester)*
- *End of 10th Grade – Percentage of students with 110 credits and a 2.0 Grade Point Average*
- *EL Student Progress*
- *California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)*
- *AP Course-taking and Exam-taking/passing*

In general, this report shows:

- Overall, relatively high achievement for the majority of students
- Persistent achievement gaps between overall student achievement and that of specific student groups. However, there is some general improvement among EL's learning English in English Language Development classes
- A dip in performance across almost all measures for 2017 (relative to 2016) across all sites and subgroups
- Excellent graduation rates and mixed results regarding students graduating UC/CSU-eligible (having met the "A-G" criteria)
- The continuance of a significant gap in performance among 11th Graders taking the CAASPP between ELA and Mathematics and a particular drop in mathematics performance among all student groups at some sites
- Significant increases in student AP test-taking over the last three years

The District and sites are taking the following actions to understand and address the issues identified in the data:

- **A-G:** Continuing to investigate & address where the barriers are & which indicator is key ("C" Grades or Course-taking?)
- **Decreasing D/F:** Reviewing progress & intervening @ first six weeks with staff & students
- **10th Graders with 110 Credits & 2.0:** Continue to monitor, intervene and provide summer school opportunities
- **CAASPP Improvement:** Focus on math: new materials, training & intervention schemes
- **EL Progress:** Continued refinement of ELD program; implement *Designated* and *Integrated ELD* for Long-Term English Learners; Summer School expansion
- **Graduation Rates:** Refining common counseling practice (facilitated by new MTSS Coordinator)
- **AP Course/Test-Taking:** Continue to conduct outreach to students; use PSAT "AP Potential" data

The district will increase by 4% the overall number of 9th grade students receiving a “C-” grade (or better) in Algebra I (fall 2017). In addition, the District will increase by 6% the number of EL, Low-Income, Foster/Homeless Youth, Special Education, Latino and Pacific Islander 9th grade students receiving a “C-” grade (or better) in Algebra I (fall 2017).
